Eligibility Criteria

- 1. Student Status
 - Currently enrolled undergraduate, master's, or doctoral students in nursing, health science, or related fields
 - Must provide official enrollment verification letter from current educational institution (to be attached with application)
 - Full-time or part-time enrollment accepted
- 2. Submitted Abstract Requirements
 - Must have submitted an abstract for consideration at DHIT 2025 conference
 - Must be first author or corresponding author of the submitted abstract
 - Abstract content must be relevant to the main conference themes: "Digital Health and Innovation in Nursing and Health Science"
 - Abstract must meet all conference submission guidelines and deadlines
- 3. No Duplicating Funding Support
 - Applicant must <u>not</u> have received funding support from other sources to attend DHIT
 2025 conference
 - Must declare any other funding applications or awards related to conference attendance
 - Commitment to ethical use of grant funds

4. Presentation Ability

- Must be able to attend and personally present their work on **November 4-5, 2025**
- Must demonstrate English language proficiency for presentation and communication

5. Research Mindset and Future Potential

For Graduate Students with Research Experience:

- Demonstrates strong research orientation and potential for future research development
- Shows inspiration and clear goals for utilizing conference experience for research advancement
- Evidence of commitment to advancing knowledge in digital health and nursing/health sciences

For Undergraduate Students or Non-Research Students:

- Demonstrates strong interest in professional development and healthcare innovation
- Shows inspiration and clear goals for utilizing conference experience for career preparation and personal growth
- Evidence of commitment to learning about digital health innovations and contributing to healthcare improvement

6. Additional Requirements

- One grant per student per conference
- Must agree to acknowledge grant support in presentation materials
- Willing to participate in post-conference evaluation and feedback activities

Benefits

- Complete waiver of conference registration fees
- Certificate of recognition
- Priority consideration for **oral presentation** slots
- Networking opportunities with international experts

Application Requirements

- 1. Completed Application Form with personal and academic information
- 2. Official Enrollment Verification Letter from current educational institution
- 3. Copy of Submitted Abstract with proof of first/corresponding author status
- 4. **Statement of Purpose** (500 words maximum) addressing the following topics

- Demonstrate your strong research orientation and potential for future research development (Graduate students) or demonstrates strong interest in professional development and healthcare innovation (Undergraduate students)
- Show inspiration and clear goals for utilizing conference experience for personal and professional development
- Provide evidence of your commitment to advancing knowledge in digital health and nursing/health sciences

Please address the following guiding questions in your statement.

- o What sparked your interest in research within digital health and nursing/health sciences?
- o How do you envision your research contributing to the field in the next 5-10 years?
- What specific aspects of the DHIT 2025 conference are you most excited to learn about and why?
- o How will attending this conference help you achieve your academic and career goals?
- What is your long-term vision for making an impact in digital health innovation?
- How do you plan to apply the knowledge and networks gained from this conference to advance your research?

5. English Proficiency Evidence (if applicable):

- o TOEFL/IELTS, or
- o Thailand-based Test scores, or
- Letter from academic advisor confirming English presentation ability, or
- o Previous conference presentation experience
- 6. Academic Transcript (unofficial copy acceptable)
